What does the course cover?

- A systematic approach to the teaching of phonics
- Core reading strategies: from early reading experiences to independent reading fluency
- Learning the language of text, story, song and rhyme and the importance of early phonological development
- Hearing and discriminating speech sounds, the importance of oral blending and segmenting
- Learning the basic and the complex phonic code
- From phonics to spelling: a systematic approach
- Planning for early language and phonics within a literacy rich curriculum in EYFS and KS1
- Building a reading community: supporting parents and carers
- Reader identity and the role of the enabling adult
- Selecting appropriate texts and mapping text potential to target gaps in phonic knowledge

- Teaching sequences for Early Years and Key Stage 1 to ensure key phonics skills are taught and applied across reading and writing. This enables participants to immediately implement their learning to trial approaches and observe impact back in their schools
- Recommendations for a range of quality texts to use to support early reading across Early Years, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2.
- Gap tasks to support reflection on current practice, trial approaches, evaluate impact and
 use what they learn across the three days to plan for sustained improvement across Early
 Years and Key Stage 1.
