Our Sports Day is set for **Tuesday 21th May.** This year, we have decided to bring Sports Day forward due to the hot weather in June/July. We are also doing things slightly different this year with the addition of another racing track.

As always, we are making special preparations for a very special day for your child. There are many exciting opportunities during the day and with the added emphasis on Year R children experiencing their first Sports Day and Year 6 their last one. It is an incredibly exciting time in and around the school.

We ask that KS1 and Reception children take their PE kits home the day before, so they can be dressed and ready for the morning. KS2 children will get dressed into their PE kits during lunch on the day. **PE kits are: House T-shirt (no football shirts), plain black or blue shorts and plimsolls/** trainers (no logos).

The fun will start at 9:00am approximately for Key Stage 1 (this year we are splitting KS1 and KS2 up- all of KS1 events will take place during the morning and all of the KS2 events will take place during the afternoon).

Due to time restrictions on the day, we have decided to announce the overall House winners in achievement assembly on Friday 24th May 2019.

We have set a date for our <u>reserve sports day</u> too. This will be on Friday 24th May 2019 (keep the date free).

There will be programmes made up on the day, which will be available on the front desk as you enter the field. Refreshments will be available throughout the day for PARENTS ONLY. Lunchtime arrangements will be as normal for children; parents are obviously welcome to picnic on the field but all children will have lunch in school. This will give us chance for the children to register for the afternoon session, to refill water bottles and generally give them the opportunity to cool down, particularly if it is a hot day!

In both the morning and afternoon sessions, the children will begin by parading round the field in their houses and waving their house colours. Additionally, we have a surprise performance from our Year 6 children with a dance.
