## PRAYER SPACE

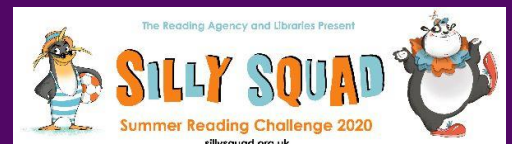
Lord,
