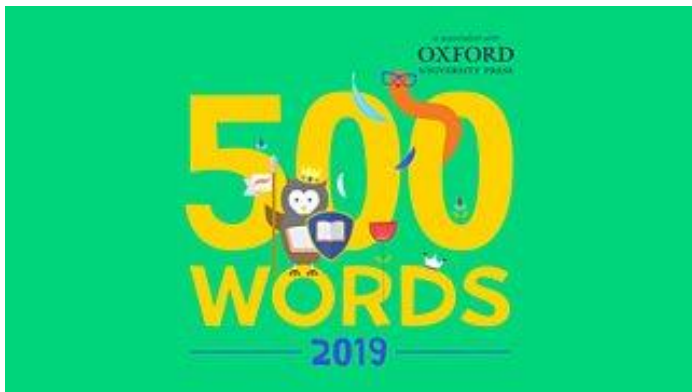

It is not too late to enter the BBC Radio 2, 500 words competition. Entries need to be in by 7pm on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2019.

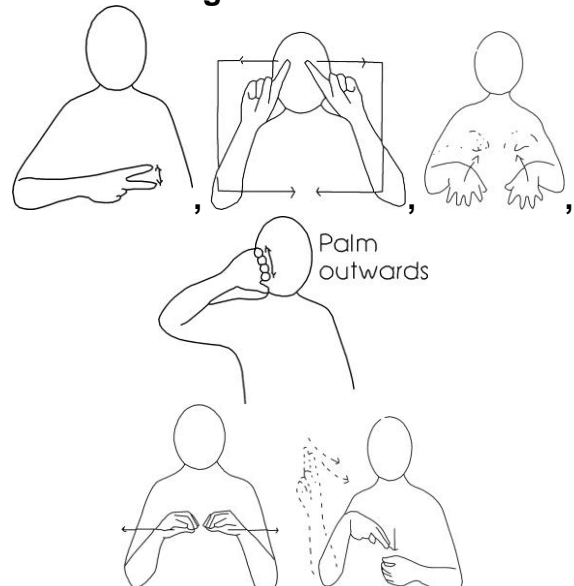
'500 words' is the UK's most successful short story writing competition for children between the ages of 5 and 13yrs old.
