Dear Parents and Carers,

We are sorry to have to write to you following some unacceptable, unhygienic and unsafe behaviours in school from some children. They have been spitting, blowing 'raspberries' in each other's faces. Some have also been picking their noses and waving dirty tissues in faces. We have a 'zero' tolerance for these behaviours.

As part of our behaviour policy there is an additional section regarding unsafe and unhygienic behaviours especially where they are deliberate. We have copied the extract from our policy below.

mouth or nose when coughing or sneezing followed by washing their hands.

Please can you talk to your child over the weekend, regarding unsafe and unhygienic behaviours and reiterate the seriousness of the consequences to them and others.

We have spoken today to a few classes telling them these behaviours will not be tolerated and have explained the consequences if they choose to ignore this. We will have no option but to send home any child whose behaviour falls below our expectations.
