A reminder:

Covid-19 case definition

- A high temperature/fever (38°C or above)
- A new continuous cough (where a conversation is impossible to be held)
- A loss of or change to your sense of taste or smell

What does isolation mean:

- ✗ **do not** go to work, school or public places – work from home if you can
- ✗ **do not** go out to get food and medicine – order it online or by phone, or ask someone to deliver
 - ✗ **do not** have visitors in your home, including friends and family
 - ✗ **do not** go on public transport or use taxis
- ✗ **do not** go out to exercise – exercise at home or in your garden
