BREAKFAST CLUB PROVISION

As you are no doubt aware, as we approach the end of term, schools in the local area are closing bubbles with positive covid cases. We are beginning to see this impact in our school, as staff are self isolating/caring for their own children in isolation from other schools.

With only a week to go, we hope that we can continue to provide for your children, however there is a very small possibility that we may need to close at short notice. We hope that this won't be necessary and have looked at several scenarios to avoid this.

We are doing our very best with the challenges of reduced staff, while continuing to keep the children and staff safe in bubbles.

Our admin team are currently filling gaps so that we can continue to provide breakfast club to children where both parents are key workers, or key worker single parents.

On our immedidate return in January, we will continue to provide for the same group of children as in term 2. Please rest assured that we will continue to review this situation as we move through 2021.

If you are a key worker and do not currently have a place, and feel that you have absolutely no alternative child care provision, please contact the school office **TO BE ADDED TO A WAITING LIST** with proof of key worker status. eg ID badge, letter from your employer.

At this point we can not consider offering to anyone other than keyworkers and this is by no means a confirmed offer of a place, just a place on a waiting list.

While we appreciate that this is not ideal for some of you. I hope you can appreciate that with the positive cases increasing in the area, and not knowing what the situation will be on our return in January, the safety of our school community is the highest priority.

Thank you for your on going support as we continue to work hard for the safety of the children and staff in difficult circumstances.
