Year 6 and Year 4 team unfortunately lost 3-2

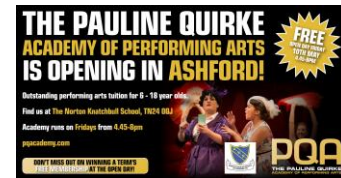
but Year 5 and Year 4 team won 4-1.
