Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to let you know that all children now have access to an online eBook library of over 5,000 books through a website called myON. For children on Accelerated Reader (AR) they will be able to link their AR account to their myON account which will enable them to search for books within their AR range (ZPD) and complete AR quizzes once they have read a book.

You can log in to myON from any computer with an Internet connection and compatible browser. For most children their AR login will be the same as their myON login, if it isn't they will be informed by their class teacher.

Please find attached a PDF document with instructions of how to get started. Please note that children will have access to all 5,000+ books, therefore we would recommend that they search for books within their AR range (ZPD) otherwise they may chose books which are not age appropriate. There is guidance of how to do this in the PDF document, you can also set up a year group preference for your child if you watch the following YouTube video this will help you further:

If your child is not yet on Accelerated Reader you will still be given a log in to the site where you can choose to look at any of the books. We hope to get these logins out to you by the end of the week. All books have audio, so if your child is unable to read the text there is an option to listen to the words being read out aloud. If your child is not on Accelerated Reader please prioritise the reading of their decodable phonics book as this is matched to their reading level and will be suitable for developing their reading.
