Workshop on zoom to make an Easter Garden – All welcome but particularly our families.

We will be making Easter gardens together and talking about what happened on that first Good Friday and Easter Day.



Some preparation on your part will be needed so on the next page you will find instructions on what you will need to do to be ready.

What to do BEFORE Good Friday

You will need to go on a scavenger hunt to find these things and then have them ready to make our gardens at home.

Inside your house, you will need to find:

- 1 A tray or large plate with a lip at the sides (so that the garden doesn't drop onto the table.)
- 2 A small flower pot or the inside of a toilet roll cut in two.
- 3 A small piece of white cloth.
- 4 Six smallish sticks to make into crosses.

Outside you will need to find:

- 1 Some soil (or if you can't get any just some old rags or socks will do so they can be scrunched to make a hill.
- 2 Some moss or a bit of turf or some green material.
- 3 Some small stones.
- 4 One large stone (to cover the entrance to the tomb.)

Optional extras:

Some small plants such as pansies, buttercups, forget me nots or daisies to bring some colour to your garden – try and dig up the roots rather than pull them up because they will die pretty quickly if you do that.

A small mirror to make a pond.

Anything small that you think would enhance your garden – you decide.
