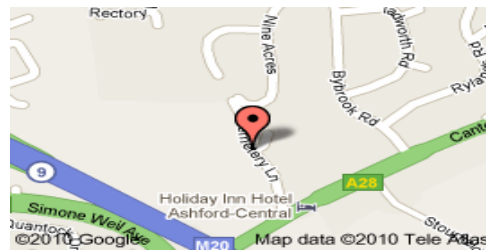

Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 4 residential trip to Kingswood - Mon 13th May -15th May 2019

To find the Kingswood centre. Please **DO NOT Google search it**. It will send you to the wrong place!



Turn left into Bybrook Barn from the A28. Follow the road up and the turning is signposted on the left. Follow the road to the electric gates. Go through the main electric gates and you need to 'keep left'. Follow it round in a circle and please drop your children outside the main entrance where we will be waiting. Please go right round as we do not want to clog the staff parking area.

If you arrive early, you will be directed to a car park, which is quite a long walk from the main entrance. Picking up will be the same routine as dropping off. Please be patient as it does take time.

<u>DROP OFF</u> Monday 13 th May '19	Between 08:45 - 09:30 (Activities commence at 09:30) Please do not arrive before 08:45
<u>PICK UP</u> Wednesday 15 th May '19	Between 14:00 (Activities end around 1:15) Please do not arrive before 14:00

If you also have a Year 2 or 6 child please take them to school first. Due to SAT's tests.

Clothing: On arrival, could children be wearing long trousers, long sleeved tops and ankle socks (not trainer socks). Please could they be dressed appropriately and have spare warm clothes, including hats and gloves. Old clothes are essential, as are old trainers, as they will get wet and dirty. If they have a dressing gown, it was not on the kit list but will be useful for going to the showers. It is not essential... They can take a teddy or other soft toy. (Please one only)

Black bin liner: Please could they bring a bin liner for their dirty wet clothes and shoes. (Yes, they will have them)

Please NO MOBILE TELEPHONES, ELECTRONIC GAMES, IPODS, MP3 PLAYERS SWEETS OR SNACKS or AEROSOL CANS. Please complete the slip at the end of this letter, as we shall be taking the contact numbers with us.
