Dear Parent/Carer

I am pleased to invite you to our Year 6 Transition Open Day on Saturday 25_{th} September from 10am-12pm. The last couple of years have been challenging for us all, not least for children moving up to secondary school in difficult circumstances and we are keen to ensure that students have the opportunity to at least visit their local secondary school before making such an important decision. It will not be possible for us to provide quite such a full interactive programme on the day as we usually would, but there will be the opportunity to tour the school, speak to staff and existing students and get a sense of the Academy and our ethos and values. I hope this will enable you to make an informed choice as to whether we are the right school for your child.

Recent years have seen many students achieve excellent results at both GCSE and A Level enabling them to move on to Higher Education, apprenticeships or employment. Ofsted last inspected the academy in 2017, confirming it continues to be considered as a 'Good' school, but this only tells you a small amount about what a school is like. Perhaps though, what we are most proud of is that we are now consistently oversubscribed in year 7, reinforcing that the local community consider us to be the school of choice for most children.

While of course our staff and students are rightly proud of the school we have become, it is important that, as a parent / carer, you visit the academy to decide whether you feel our school is the right one for your child. We have the most success with students whose parents share our vision and support us, whether through our behaviour and uniform policies, supporting students' work at home or through the vast range of extra-curricular activities we are able to offer.

Doors will open at 10am, please come to the main reception when you arrive to register; this year we will be sending our prospectus and other documents electronically, so this is really important. Then you are welcome to attend a talk in the Theatre and tour the academy. Staff and students will be available for you to speak to as you look around.
