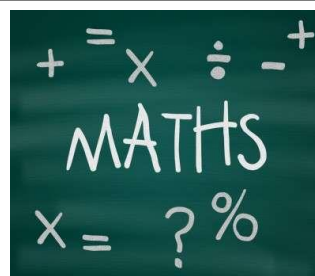
Entries for the 2019 [Soltan Sun Ready Campaign Challenge](#) are now open!
