

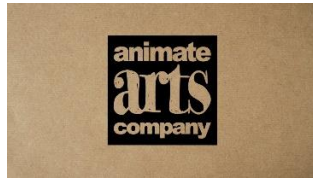

Dear Parents,

Exciting news! Wolf Class have been invited to take part in a special arts project, working alongside the fantastic Animate Arts Company.

As part of the project, three Ashford based primary schools will work with professional artists from Animate Arts to create a Cardboard Orchestra. Pupils will build their very own orchestra of instruments entirely from paper and cardboard matter. Each pupil will have their part to play in a magical 'mimed' performance programmed for Revelation Ashford's main stage on **Wednesday 12 June 2019**. The performance will be ticketed – more information will follow for those who would like to come and watch! There will be a **cost of £3.60 per child** to cover transport. Please pay this amount by Scopay no later than the 5th June. On this day, the children will also need a packed lunch.

Wolf Class will take part in two workshops prior to the performance day. Workshop 1 will be on **Friday 17th May** with the second workshop on the following **Wednesday 22nd May**.

The project offers the children the opportunity to learn about orchestras, discover a piece of music and plan their own part in the orchestra. They will work with visual artists to develop their own cardboard and paper instruments and will also have the chance to work with musicians from Rose Bruford College, who will play live music whilst the children create. Working with the musicians, the class will develop their performance values and orchestra knowledge, to support their final performance. Although they will be a miming orchestra, we want them to deliver their show with conviction, expertise and passion!

If you have any cardboard boxes or tubes, or any newspaper that could help the children please could it be brought to school by Friday 17th May.

Also, apologies for the short notice but please sign the slip below to give written permission for the children to be photographed and/or filmed during the project. **Please return the consent form by Friday 14th May.**

Animate Arts state that the photos and recordings could be used in:
