GB Athlete visit

This Thursday 23rd May we have been visited by Ezekiel Ewulo who is a Great British and Nigerian long jumper who has won over 300 medals in his career as an athlete. He first achieved a Bronze medal in 2005 at the England Indoor Championships and shortly after, in the same year, won Gold at the England International Junior Championships. In 2011, he became the UK Indoor Senior Champion but then decided to go back to his roots and began training to represent Nigeria at the All African finals.

The children have completed a number of activities and helped to raise a massive £1150.32 for our GB athletes, which will go towards their training and funding for competitions. On top of this, we have also raised £1725.48 for the school.

The children have yet again shown all the school values during their participation and the lead up to this event and we are very proud of every one of them for completing their activities.
