We are very grateful to the PFA for running a tombola for all children today – this was much fun and hugely appreciated.

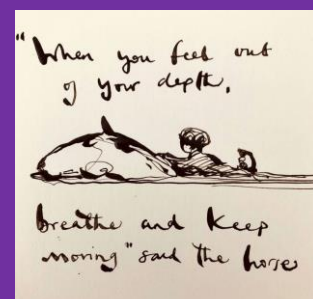
Our focus for online safety this week is an attached information page shared by Kent Police. I hope that you find this useful.
