Dear Parents / Carers

School Jubilee Picnic – Friday 27 May

We are looking forward to welcoming you to school on Friday in order to celebrate the Queens' Jubilee and the wonderful work that your child has produced for this. I wanted to share some information about the arrangements for Friday that we hope will be a useful reference guide for the afternoon;

- KS2 parents enter school through wooden gates by the field
- EYFS and KS1 parents enter through the green gate by EYFS playground
- All parents will be asked to sign in against their child's name for Health and Safety purposes
- All gates will be closed at 12.15pm for purposes of Safeguarding; if you arrive after this time, please come to the school main Reception
- Parents are invited to go to their child's classroom door on the playground in order to meet their child. You are very welcome to enter the classroom and view the child's exhibition work at this time
- The rest of the school building will not be open for adults or children
- Parents are invited to picnic on the playground or grass; parents with siblings are invited to stay on the KS1 playground with their older siblings. This will allow comfortable space for all
- Parents are invited to bring their own blankets or seating for the picnic; there will be some seating available
- Toilets in the Old School Hall will be open for adults only
- Children will be directed to toilets inside school
- The school apparatus will **not be open** for the children to use; please help us to remind them. Children will remain in the care of their parents during this time with support from our school team. There will be **no football or ball sports** available for Health and Safety reasons. The children are expected to stay with their family group during the picnic
- The PFA have arranged for the purchase of ice creams during lunchtime; please remember to bring some money if you would like. If your child has any allergies, please declare these at point of purchase
- Children will return to class at 1.15pm for afternoon register; gates will open at this time. If you need to leave before 1.15pm please speak to one of the school team and we will be very pleased to help you
- Children may leave with families from 1.30pm
