A message from the Aquila Diocese Canterbury Academies Trust:-

A push for pushchairs - Refugees and asylum seekers arrive in the UK in just the clothes they stand up in and need support for their babies and children. The cost of pushchairs is just unbearable for refugee parents and yet so many unwanted prams, in good condition, end up in landfill – or stuck in the loft.

Not having access to a suitable pushchair means many refugee parents are unable to get outside and access much-needed fresh air and headspace. This can affect their mental health and wellbeing and hinders accessing services and other activities to help community connections such as our weekly drop ins.
