Dear Parents / Carers

Year 6 Leavers' Assembly

I am delighted to confirm the arrangements for the Year 6 Leavers' Assembly on **Thursday 21 July at 11am in the school hall**. We would like to invite a maximum of **two parents for each child**; this will allow us to safely seat children from school and to keep everyone safe in the face of rising local COVID cases. You will be asked to sign in at the green gates which we have used as an entrance point for all our class assemblies this academic year.

Please find below the details for the Assembly and for lunch arrangements thereafter;

- **10.45am maximum of two parents** sign in and invited to take seats in hall
- Siblings of Year 6 children will be invited to attend the assembly; all other children will watch via a TEAMS link in their classrooms. There is not enough capacity to host the whole school and our parents
- Assembly is scheduled to last approximately 40 minutes
- Children will return to class after the assembly; Year 6 parents are invited to have a picnic with their child in the Year 6 outdoor area or in classrooms if temperatures are oppressive. This allows the rest of the school to use the playground for their lunchtime
- Year 6 children will return to class at 12.45 in order to complete their final registration and to prepare for the end of the day
- At 1.30pm Year 6 pupils will exit the side door of the building and be clapped out of school. Parents are invited to wait at the other side of the wooden gate in order to allow the Teaching team and other children from school to form a "guard of honour line"
- The rest of the school will be released at 1.15pm in order to allow focus on the Year 6 children leaving school

I hope that you will be able to join us on the final celebration event for your children.
