A message from Miss Moore, Assistant Head and Senco

It has been a real privilege to meet, and get to know the children since joining the school in September. I thank parents for making me feel welcome, especially when I have met with you or have seen parents on the school gate.

I have been thinking about the school, and how I can create areas within the classrooms to help support children to regulate and have a break from their learning. I have ordered some bean bags to help create these spaces, giving children a different space to sit, allowing them to take time if they need it.

Staff in the school are really good at supporting children with regulating and will notice when children need to have a short break from learning.

We talk to the children about zones of regulation, and how emotions make us feel, children need to understand different emotions and what they may feel like in different contexts.

Try to focus on the positives at home and encourage your child to talk about something positive that happened during the day and how that made them feel. This will help children think and feel positive which will help their wellbeing, helping them to be calm and happy.
