A message from Miss Moore, Assistant Headteacher & Senco.

It has been a joy to see the children back after the break, they are full of enthusiasm and ready to learn.

I am focusing on communication with the children, this includes non-verbal communication, and body language. Knowing what children are trying to communicate to us when their language skills are limited, and how we react, is important.

Children need us to help them communicate at any age, and help to be understood, this can be challenging at times, but it is important that as adults we stay calm, and try to understand what our children are trying to tell us.

At home you can help your child by having some family time, talking about things that worry us, or make us feel anxious. Feeling anxious or worried is a normal feeling and often working out what our children are trying to say can be more successful when you are having fun together and children are feeling relaxed, playing a game, cooking together, going for a walk are examples I hope you will try and enjoy.

I would also like to take this opportunity to ask you to look out for my parent coffee mornings which I will be inviting parents to this term, I look forward to seeing you there.

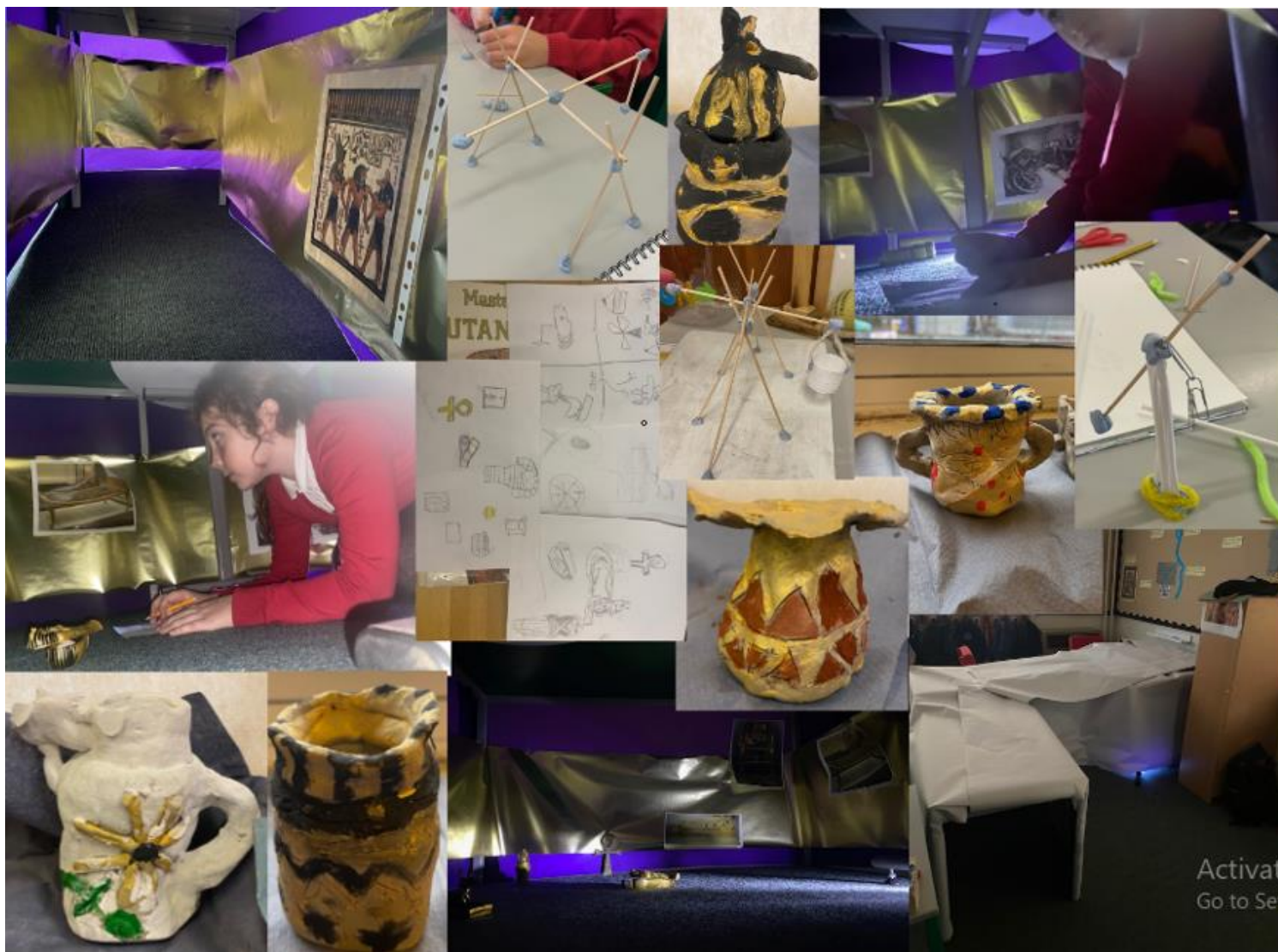
