Changes to Teaching Team in 5F

Further to my letter dated 10th February, I am very pleased to be able to confirm the new teaching team in 5F with effect from Term 5, after the Easter holidays.

We are delighted to announce Mrs Amy Andrews will be working with Sachar Class. Mrs Andrews has worked with the class before and knows the children. This will provide vital consistency for the children during the summer terms. Mrs Andrews will be in class every Tuesday and Wednesday.
