We will send home a yellow reading log for you to record your child's progress. Please complete the reading tasks which are stuck into the front of the log. Children will then go

onto telling their own stories using picture books with no words. Please try and read with your child on a daily basis as this will help them immensely with their learning. Your child will need their **reading log and reading book** in school **each day**, even if you haven't read at home so that we can read with them in school. Books will be changed on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday.



To support your child to learn to read we will be teaching phonics using the Read Write Inc. programme. We will send the sounds we have learnt home daily – please keep these at home for your child to review and practise.

We will be holding a Read Write Inc Parent Workshop on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September at 9am in the school hall. All parents and carers welcome.
