If there are any issues, please E-mail us and we will get back to you. Please find below, most of the important features of what we will be covering in Year 4 this term.

### Readina

Please remember to pack your child a fruit or vegetable snack for breaktime, sweets and chocolate are not permitted.

Please try and read with your child on a daily basis and sign their log. Reading is the key to accessing the rest of the curriculum. Your child will need their reading log and reading book in school each day, even if you haven't read at home so that we can monitor their progress. Children will change their books independently.

Our class books will focus on our class Authors this term, Joseph Coelho and Rick Riordan.

This term in Maths, we will be ensuring that the children have a secure understanding of Place Value, including rounding, partitioning, comparing and ordering Numbers to 10,000, and introducing Roman numerals.

We will then apply our understanding through addition and subtraction of 4-digit numbers, using efficient methods and solve a range of mathematical problems. The children will estimate answers in order to check calculation strategies.

Living Things in their Habitats. How can we group and identify a variety of living things? The children will explore the different Habitats both in our locality and beyond. Outdoor Learning - Classifying Pond **Plants** 

In PSHE, the children will be learning about 'Being Me in our World and exploring being part of a team. They talk about attitudes and actions and their effects on the whole class. The children learn about their school and its community, who all the different people are and what their roles are. They will also refresh their understanding of the School Rule and good learning behaviours.
