Celebrating Our Sisters



Anne-Marie excelled at school from an incredibly young age. She became the youngest person to pass an A-level in Computing at the tender age of 11. Continuing her studies, she went on to receive a master's degree in Mathematics and Computer Science from the University of Oxford, aged only 20 years old.

Anne-Marie founded the
Stemettes in 2013 because
she was worried about
the lack of young women
training for jobs STEM,
which stands for Science,
Technology, Engineering
and Mathematics. The
Stemettes mission is to
ensure every young woman
knows her potential in the fields
of science and innovation.

I quickly realised that the only way to address the lack of women in STEM was to inspire the next generation.
