## A message from Mr Witts, Headteacher

A warm welcome back after the Half-Term break. What an exciting week it has been.

It has been fantastic to see the wonderful smiling faces of the children and seeing the exciting lessons in the classroom. I have seen some lovely art lessons and fascinating science learning.

After issues with our heating systems earlier in the week, we now have a temporary fix which allows the heating to be on – very necessary as we experienced the storm this week. I hope you all managed to stay safe and well.

# **Kent Closure Information**


As we enter the winter season, please can you make sure to sign up to the Kent Closures website https://kentclosures.co.uk/ ahead of more challenging weather.
