Reading

Reading books will be changed if they've been read at least twice with an

adult. Please continue to listen to your child read <u>daily</u> and send their books in every day. We have a 15 minute daily quiet reading session when we listen to children read. The children that read daily make accelerated progress in this area.



Maths

This term we will begin by focusing on addition and subtraction. The children will have the opportunity to use manipulatives to help them explain answers whilst building on mathematical language. We will be learning and using the number bonds to 10.



Wider curriculum

In Science, we will be looking at Animals including Humans and naming body parts and functions – 'Where is my head?'. History will focus on Guy Fawkes and his Gun Powder plot – 'Is it right to burn Guy?'. In DT we will be designing and making Christmas cards that move – 'Can I make something special?' Music will focus on beat and performance – 'How can we change the pitch?' and in Computing we will look at technology around our lives – 'Are computers only used for games?'



PSHE

In Jigsaw we will be looking at the pieces called 'Celebrating Differences'. During this we will discuss how we are all special and unique- 'Who is more special?'



RE

In RE this term we will focus on Advent and the run up to Christmas, thinking about how we show we are thankful for many things and making link to the Christmas story. Our big question is 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?'

<u>Water Bottles</u> Please make sure your child brings a <u>named</u>, clear, <u>water</u> bottle to school **every day**. The children will have access to these during the day and have resources to refill if necessary.
