Reading As some of the reading books are becoming longer you may not complete the whole book in one

evening, however *please send in your child's reading* book everyday as we have a 20-minute quiet reading session daily where your child will be able to continue reading their book. Please continue to question your child's comprehension of their reading book and encourage them to read with increasing fluency.



Maths

Please continue to support your child at home by playing games that involve counting, adding, subtracting. Encourage the children to explain how they know that they have the correct answer. We start the term by focusing on Place Value within 20, including developing the use of Mathematical language to explain and give reasons for answers. The children will have opportunities to use manipulatives and draw mathematical pictures. This will support them ready to move onto Addition and Subtraction within 20.



Wider curriculum

Geography will focus on the UK, its capital cities and the surrounding seas, 'Where do I live?'. In Art, we will be looking at colour and how to make new colours, 'can we make all the colours of the rainbow?'. In Music we are going to be singing Seasonal songs and making machine noises, 'can you keep a steady beat?' In Science this term we will be focusing on materials and exploring their properties, 'what should I use for an umbrella?'. Computing will focus on being safe on the internet and what do to if we feel afraid, 'How can I be safe online?'



RE - Christianity

In RE this term we will be focusing on the Gospels and the Good news that Jesus brings. We will talk about stories in the Bible and our schools' Christian values. 'What is the good news Jesus brings?'



PSHE/JIGSAW

In Jigsaw this term we will be looking at our 'Dreams and Goals' for the future. This will include working on resilience, setting goals, working with others successfully, overcoming obstacles and celebrating successes. 'What sort of person do you want to be?'
