In RE this term we will be looking at the religion Judaism. Within this we will find out about celebrations, traditions, foods, symbols, artefacts and places of worship. We will make comparisons to Christianity and learn about how children follow Judaism. **'Who is Jewish and what do they believe?'**

Reading

Thank you for all your support with reading. **Please send in your child's reading book everyday** as we have a 20 minute quiet reading session daily where your child will be able to continue reading their book either individually or with an adult.



Wider Curriculum



Our topic this term will include History (significant people from the past). We will be finding out about Rosa Parks and Emily Davidson. **'Who changed the world?'** Our Art this term will focus on sketching, using a pencil to carefully add detail. **'Can I use different art to express myself?'** In PSHE we will be focusing on Relationships. How to build positive and safe relationships and handling situations when things get tricky or challenging with our friends. **'How can I make positive relationships?'** Music will consist of performing pieces and using our voices. **'How can I explore sounds and perform sounds?'** And in computing we will be looking at basic programming. **'Can I make it on my computer?'**



Maths

We will be moving onto Time in Maths at the beginning of the term before moving onto Multiplication and Division. We will be using our skills in addition and subtraction and place value to help with this. We will continue to use pictures, manipulatives and mathematical language to explain our answers.



We will be looking at Plants this term. During Science lessons we will learn about the parts of a plant and tree, understand what plants need to grow and know the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees. **'What grows in my garden?'**
