As we start the new academic year we are already planning and thinking and looking forward to the next academic year, and children who will be starting their school journey in September 2025. We are going to host some events, working with the English hub to promote reading and phonics. Our first reading event will begin on Tuesday 1st October 2024 2:15 - 3pm which will take place in the main hall.
