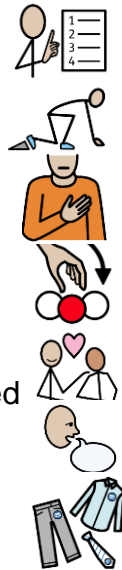


Together we will all:
