Clubs for this term - After school and lunchtime clubs will start from next week.

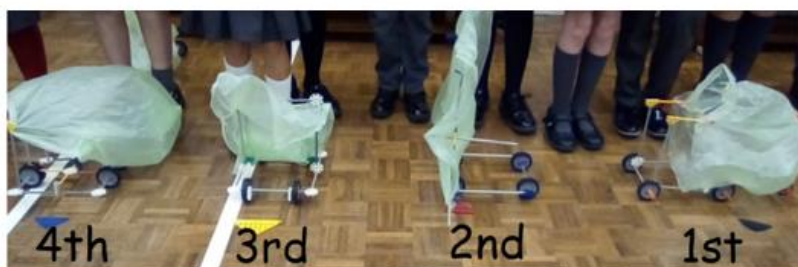
Attendance every day counts.
