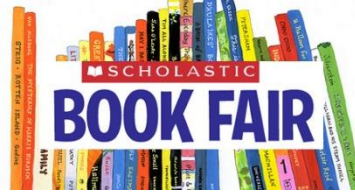


Laptop

Dear Parent/Carers

I am very aware that many families in the Kingsnorth Primary School community reside in the Knights Park / Chartfields area, which are part of my ward. One issue, which has been raised with me repeatedly by residents, are their concerns regarding the safety of Britannia Lane, and in particular, concerns regarding children being able to safely cross the road on their journeys to and from school.

As you will probably be aware, the road network and road safety initiatives fall under KCC not the borough council. I have raised the issues directly with KCC and have been told that as there hasn't been a fatality yet, the safety improvements suggested by the residents isn't justified. Therefore, at local resident's request I have started a petition to Kent County Council calling for safety improvements to be made to Britannia Lane and Chart Road.

We need to get 1000 signatures on the petition for it to be debated at County Hall, and I was wondering if I could ask that Kingsnorth Primary School lend their support to this cause? For example, by sharing with the wider school community via social media / newsletters?
