Medication

If your child is unwell parents will be contacted. The school has limited medication and is used for **emergencies** only. If medication is required, parents may be asked to come to the school to administer it themselves. If your child suffers from hay fever, medication **must** be administered before school.

However, prescription medication can be administered, at a parent's request by completing a medical form from the school office, on the following basis:

- Medicine has been prescribed by a doctor
- The container must have the child's name printed
- Medicine needs to be taken a minimum of 4 times a day
