Jaxon in Y1 attended an interclub martial arts tournament last weekend. Jaxon achieved 2 golds and 1 silver in the 3 events.

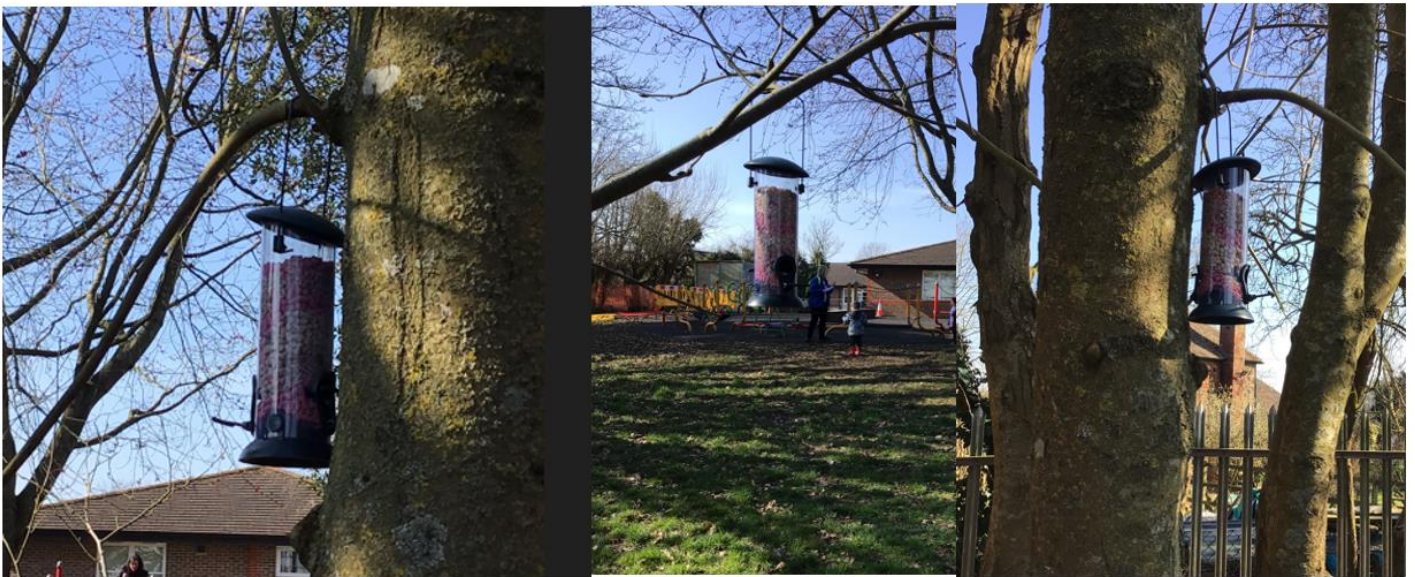
