# Food



3 meals a day. Dietary needs – we take lanyards. In previous years, children with dietary needs go first.

- Breakfast
  - Cereals, toast, butter, jam, yoghurt. Everyday.
    - Either hot cooked breakfast  
or
    - Continental breakfast
  
- Lunch
  - Always hot with a choice of 3 dishes... also jacket potatoes with a choice of fillings. Ham Cheese Tuna and salad.
  
- Dinner
  - Always different hot options with a choice of pudding.



# Behaviour



- We will follow the school behaviour system:
