Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to share some exciting updates about our school's Breakfast Club and the changes that will be implemented from Term 5 onwards.

As you may already know, we have been selected to be part of the Government's Early Adopters Scheme for Breakfast Clubs. We are working closely with the Department for Education (DfE) to ensure a smooth roll-out of the programme.

Given that our Breakfast Club is already well-established and offers a service that goes above and beyond the requirements of the DfE scheme, we have collaborated with the DfE to create a tailored package for our parents/families.

As part of the Early Adopters scheme, we are pleased to announce that we will be able to reduce the cost of Breakfast Club from £3 to a maximum £2 per session. This represents a significant saving, and we hope many of you will appreciate the reduction. If in receipt of Pupil Premium please contact the office directly.

The timings for Breakfast Club will remain the same, with doors opening at 7:45am. Children will stay in the club until 8:40am, at which point they will be escorted to their classrooms to ensure they are ready for the morning register at 8:45am. Breakfast will be served by 8:15am each morning, so children need to arrive by 8:15am to receive breakfast.

For families who are already enrolled in Breakfast Club, there is no action needed – your place is guaranteed, and the service will continue as normal.

Please could we ask that you continue to pre-book your places via MCAS as this will allow us to maintain attendance levels safely.

As part of the Early Adopters scheme, we are now able to offer additional places to children and families who may be interested in joining the Breakfast Club. This will be limited at 100 children due to Health and Safety factors.

If you would like your child(ren) to attend Breakfast Club from 7:45am to 8:40am for a maximum of £2 per session, please express your interest by emailing us at [breakfastclub@kingsnorth.kent.sch.uk](mailto:breakfastclub@kingsnorth.kent.sch.uk)

Places will need to be booked a week in advance, via the email address above.
