## Fire Talks

On Wednesday we had Corrine from the Fire Service visit our school to give talks to each year group.

Year 5 and 6 were taught how to understand the potential risks caused by electricity. They learnt safer behaviours around electricity and the importance of electrical safety, especially when charging their devices.

We played a game of 'Like or swipe'. It involved pictures and we had to use our knowledge to help us decide if it was safe or unsafe using the SMART charger words: Safe, Mindful, Awake and Alert, Responsible, There.

Please ask the children how they can be SMARTer with fire safety and share some of the information that they have learnt.

Year R have enjoyed learning about Fire and Rescue. They were taught what to do in an emergency. We have been role playing, taking emergency calls and being fire fighters. Lots of water has been used this week to put out fires... and cool us down!
