Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to announce that on **Monday 2nd March**, we will be introducing World Book Week 2026. We have the Ashford Mobile Library visiting Kingsnorth School so that the children can borrow a book with their friends! What a lovely way to kick start World Book Week!

To ensure your child has the best experience on the day, they will need to be signed up for a library card. If your child does not have a library card, please could you fill in the sign-up form making its way home in book bags, and return the forms by **Friday 6th February** to your child's teacher. These will be processed by Ashford Library and your child will be given a library card in return.

On the day of the mobile visit, your child will use their card to borrow **one book** from the library which can be returned directly to any Kent Library, or brought back to school for the library to collect on your behalf.

A library card can be used in any library in Kent:

- Books can be borrowed for up to 3 weeks
- You can return books and other items to any Kent Library. Often there is a drop box outside the library where you can leave books out of hours too.
- All of the books and other resources available in Kent Libraries are listed online: www.kent.gov.uk/libraries
- Children, young persons and adults can all borrow up to 30 items on their library card.
- Books and children's audio books are free
