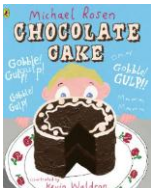
Eddie has also qualified for the South East Regional Championships in May.

KS1 - Chocolate Cake by Michael Rosen. *When a young boy sneaks downstairs at night, his plan to just look at the chocolate cake turns into full blown midnight feast. The laugh out loud poetic narrative captures his attempts to clean up the mess. With illustrations and lively text layouts and speech bubbles ramps up Rosen's sense of fun.*

KS2 - Kate on the Case by Hannah Peck. *Kate, a wannabe journalist, and her mouse companion Rupert set out to find out who is behind a sequence of bizarre happenings aboard a train. Can they find the thief before the train reaches the Arctic? This is a fast paced, illustrated chapter book suitable for independent readers.*



KS2 - Crater Lake by Jennifer Killick. *When Lance sets foot in the Crater Lake activity centre, little does he realise what awaits him and his friends. Will they be able to stop aliens in time before they brainwash all their teachers and classmates? A cracking creepy page turner for independent readers.*
