## Communication Adjustments

### Class Dojo

Thank you for your continued support as we have implemented our new reward system, Class Dojo, across the school. Feedback from both parents and pupils has been overwhelmingly positive, and we are now progressing to the next phase of utilising Class Dojo to enhance our communication with you.

We're excited to introduce Class Dojo Stories as part of our new home-school communication platform. The Story function at two levels. Firstly, there will be a whole-school story accessible to all, serving as an additional reminder of upcoming events and themed days alongside the school newsletter. Teachers will be sharing updates and photos of the children working hard, taking part in activities, and enjoying their learning. This will give you a wonderful insight into your child's school day and help celebrate their achievements with you. We trust you will find this development both informative and engaging as we continue to embed Class Dojo within our school community.

Class Dojo is a secure platform, and content is only shared with parents and carers linked to our school community. We kindly ask that any photos or posts shared on Class Dojo are not copied, downloaded or shared on social media, other platforms, or in private messages, in order to protect the privacy of all children.

If you would prefer that your child's photo is not shared on our new communication platform, please contact the school office and we will ensure your wishes are respected.

Please note that as the Year R teachers currently use 'Evidence Me' to communicate what the children have been doing with you, they will continue to use this platform rather than the stories feature on Class Dojo for the rest of the year.

### Feedback Following Behavioural Incidents

In response to valuable feedback from parents expressing a desire for greater insight into their child's behaviour at school, we are introducing an adjustment to our behaviour management communication. From Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> February, we will trial a system whereby the paper reflection sheets completed by your child during restorative and reflective conversations with staff will be sent home for your review and discussion.



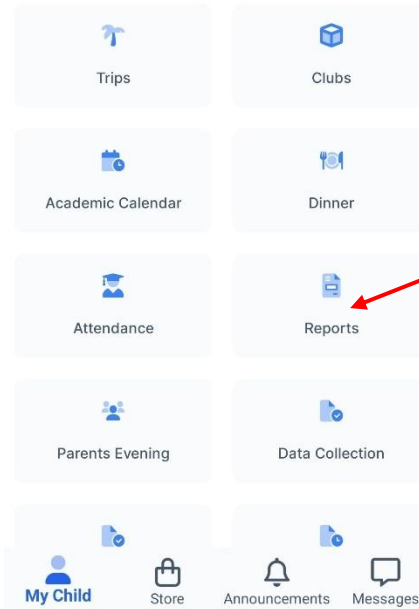
