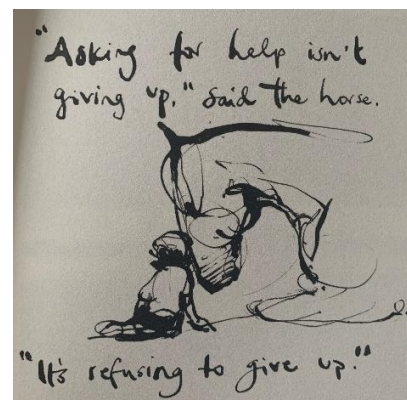

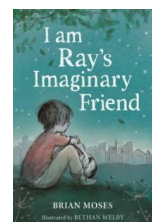
Reading for Pleasure

Books of the Month



KS1 - Mo's Stick by Fiona Lumbers. *Mo, a mouse, loses a favourite stick and feels its absence, thinking back to the imaginative games it powered, from sailing at sea to travelling into space. As he looks for a replacement, the story cleverly makes it clear that the play came from Mo's mind rather than the object. This colourful and engaging book supports discussion about imagination and creative play.*

KS2 - I am Ray's Imaginary Friend by Brian Moses. *Ray's imaginary friend narrates this spellbinding story, stepping in at the moment Ray learns his parents are thinking about moving house. The friend becomes the confidant and holder of Ray's fears and worries as he considers running away. But a new home brings new faces, including a refugee mother and child who join the family, and Ray slowly begins to feel at home. Thought provoking, heart warming and beautifully written.*



On Wednesday the children took part in a special Easter Agape, sharing bread and water as they reflected on the themes of love, hope and new beginnings. The Easter Story basket helped to understand and retell the Easter story in a meaningful way.
