Reading



Please continue to listen to your child read daily at home and ask them questions about the story to develop their reading skills. Skills such as prediction and retelling are important along with answering inference questions. Please also work through the SAT's practise book to support your child in answering written comprehension questions.



History

What was Victorian Kingsnorth like?

We will be learning about the history of Ashford. We will be finding out how old Ashford is and compare the town in terms of the past and the present. We will develop enquiry skills, such as using information and photographs to research past events.

Maths



In Maths, we will be practising arithmetic questions with all four operations. We will also be moving on to learning about 2D and 3D shapes, money and fractions. Please continue to use TT Rockstars and to work through the SAT's practise book.



English

We will continue to practise blending sounds to read. We will also be focusing more on reading skills including speed reading for fluency, adding intonation and expression as well as showing understanding of what we have read (comprehension). We will be developing our writing skills in our Writing for Pleasure lessons. We will finish our information and me books and then go onto our next writing project – writing chapter books. We will also continue to practise the skill of editing and proof-reading our writing.

PE



Our unit across this term will be striking and fielding. PE is on Tuesdays and Fridays. Your child can wear their PE kit throughout the day.

PSHE



We follow Jigsaw for our PSHE learning. This term we will be focusing on "Healthy relationships". This will involve discussions about family and friends and how we know when a relationship is a positive one.



RE

Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

In RE this term, we will be exploring the religion of Islam and we will learn about Muslim people's beliefs. We will also relate this to our own experiences and beliefs and those of the religions and world views we have already learnt about.

Science



Our unit across the next two terms is Plants. We will be learning to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants; and find out and describe how plants need water, light and suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
