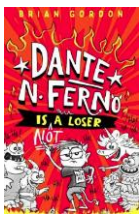
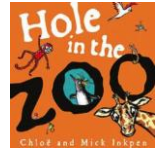
Reading for Pleasure

KS1 - The Big Journey by Michael Rosen. *As the seasons change and food runs short, Big Bear and Little Bear leave home and set out across the mountains in search of somewhere new. Their epic journey is shaped by Little Bear's worries, the danger they encounter and the animals who help them along with way.*

KS1 - Hole in the Zoo by Chloe and Mick Inkpen. *There's a hole in the wall at the local zoo, and all the animals have started coming through in this madcap and addictive rhyming story that children will want to read over and over again. A laugh out loud book to be enjoyed by all.*
