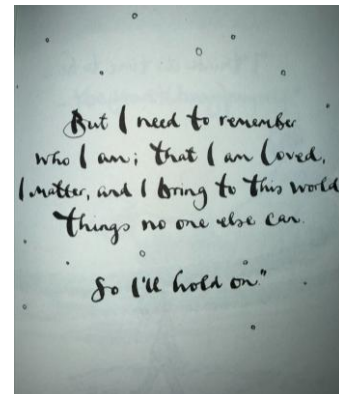

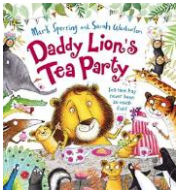

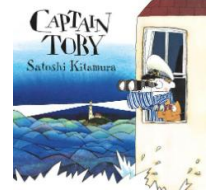
Reading for Pleasure

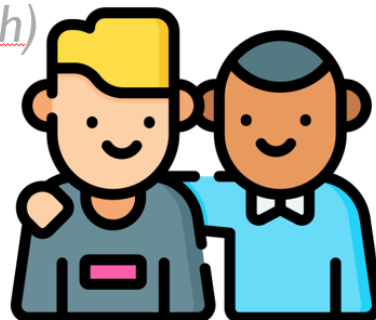
