Weekly Book Recommendations



KS1 - Gobbolino the Witch's Cat by Ursula Williams. *Gobbolino is a witch's cat who longs to be someone's pet. His search for a new home doesn't start well as mysterious and strange things seem to happen all around him. This is a more advanced short chapter book for independent and greater depth readers in Year 2, also a captivating and page turning book.*

KS2 - The Boy with Big Decisions by Helen Rutter. *Fred's never been great at making decisions, always going along with what his parents pick. When he ends up at a school he doesn't like, he spots a bus to one he'd actually enjoy. This interactive book reflects real life and school based situations.*



KS2 - The Crowstarver by Dick King-Smith. *Left abandoned as a baby on a farm, Simon Sparrow lives a tough life. However, he has an amazing gift. Every animal he meets understands and trusts him. A more challenging book, this award winning children's novel explores farming life, our relationship with animals and what defines friendship and loyalty.*

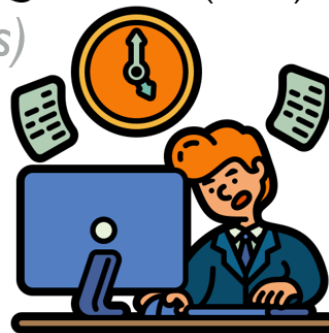
