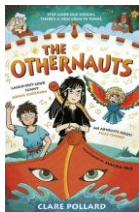
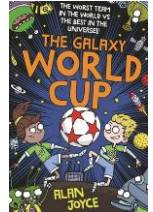
Reading for Pleasure

KS1 - The Perfect Match by Chris Becker. *Every night, Jack asks his dad for his favourite bedtime story: the story of Leo, who loved football more than anything in the world. Unfortunately, Leo is never allowed to play football with his brothers, who make him do all the housework instead. A Cinderella story with a football twist is a lovely tale about resilience, trying hard and making your wishes come true.*

KS2 - The Galaxy World Cup by Alan Joyce. *Nick and his friends Eddie, Mia, Sanjay and Phil are abducted from detention by aliens, who whisk them across the Milky Way to Planer Bigpu. The aliens have mistaken them for the world's best football players, when in fact they can barely pass a ball between them. This fast paced alien adventure is packed full of laugh out loud humour, football chants and rousing team talks*



KS2 - The Othernavts by Clare Pollard. *This hilarious retelling of the classic Greek myth Jason and the Argonauts centres around feisty 11 year old Phoebe, who lives on the island of Lemnos. Bored of her dull, uneventful life, Phoebe can't believe her luck when the Argo sails into harbour during a storm. Seizing the opportunity for adventure, she stows away on board the great ship. Bursting with humour and mayhem, this retelling remains largely true to the original while presenting the story in a fresh, funny way.*
