School Food & Free School Meals

If you are on benefits, your child may be entitled to free school meals no matter what year they are in.

You are entitled to free school meals if you receive any of the following benefits:

Income support

Income based job seekers allowance

Income related employment and support allowance

Child tax credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, provided they are not receiving working tax credit

The guaranteed element of the state pension credit

Support under Part VI of the immigration and Asylum act 1999

Universal credit, if you apply on or after 1st April 2018, your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they will continue to receive them until they move to a new stage of school, such as primary into secondary school.

Universal Infant free school meals

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 in state-funded schools in England receive free school meals. You do not need to apply for infant free school meals.

If you are on benefits and your child is entitled to universal infant free school meals anyway, it is still important to register for a free school meal to ensure Kingsnorth received funding called Pupil Premium to support your child's education.
