Home learning opportunities

A big reminder to continue daily reading with your children at home. We recommend a minimum of 20 minutes. We have a particular focus on fluency and the ability to read over 100 words per minute using some expression. We also highly recommend daily practice of spellings on Spelling Shed and times tables practice.

Maths

This term in Maths, the children will be learning about fractions, including comparing and ordering fractions, understanding non-unit fractions, and adding and subtracting fractions. They will also explore geometry by identifying parallel sides in polygons. The children will also continue developing their time skills by telling the time to the nearest minute.

Science

This term we will be focussing on Scientific Enquiry. We will be carrying out a range of experiments that help us develop our questioning, make predictions, record results and write conclusions. We will focus on observing over time, pattern seeking and comparative testing..

Jigsaw

Our Jigsaw lessons this term include discussions on how everyone is unique and different; we will look at outside and inside body changes, hygiene, looking how babies grow and looking ahead.

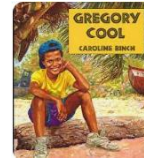

In Shared Reading this term we will be reading Gregory Cool by Caroline Binch. This is the touching story of a boy named Gregory, a cool city kid who is miserable when he arrives in Tobago to visit relatives.

English

Physical Education

PE will be on a Monday and Wednesday afternoon for Year 3. Please make sure your child wears the appropriate PE kit and no earrings on PE day. Our sports are Tennis and Athletics. Children will need their outdoor PE kit, as the warmer weather approaches children will need shorts.

Religious Education

In RE this term we will be looking at Sikhi. Our key question is: How do Sikh people worship and celebrate? The children will learn about how where and why Sikhs worship, how Sikh people respect and regard The Guru Granth Sahib as a living Guru, that the Gurdwara is place that is welcome and open to everyone and is known as the 'doorway to the house of God'.

Geography

We will be learning about Locational Knowledge. Our key question: Where in the world do we live? We will be using maps to locate the continent Europe and identifying countries in Europe. We will also be identifying human and physical features of places in Europe.
