## Maths

This term we will cover Shape and Geometry along with finishing off our statistics unit. Children should still refer to their SATS revision booklets to support the learning in Term 6. Children should continue to study at home with these books in preparation for secondary school.

## PSHE

### Changing me

In this Puzzle piece, the children learn about puberty in boys and girls and the changes that will happen; they reflect on how they feel about these changes. The children also learn about childbirth and the stages of development of a baby, starting at conception.

They explore what it means to be being physically attracted to someone and the affect this can have upon the relationship. They learn about different relationships and the importance of mutual respect and not pressuring/being pressured into doing something that they don't want to. The children also learn about self-esteem, why it is important and ways to develop it. Finally, they look at the transition to secondary school and what they are looking forward to/are worried about and how they can prepare themselves mentally.

## Production

This term we will be spending a lot of time practicing our stage skills, including voice projection, stage movement and confidence. Ourselves and the children are very much looking forward to you watching their hard work and commitment to the show.

## Writing and Reading

We will be reading Macbeth this term and focusing on our speaking and listening skills. We will be using time to practise our Performance: developing our stage presence and fluency when speaking our roles.

## Religious Education

Our Term 6 RE topic – 'What kind of King is Jesus?' Children will explain connections between biblical texts and the concept of the Kingdom of God. They will make clear connections between belief in the Kingdom of God and how Christians put their beliefs into practice in different ways, including in worship and in service to the community. Children will relate Christian teachings or beliefs about God's Kingdom to the issues, problems and opportunities of their own lives and the life of their own community in the world today, offering insights about whether or not the world could or should learn from Christian ideas.
